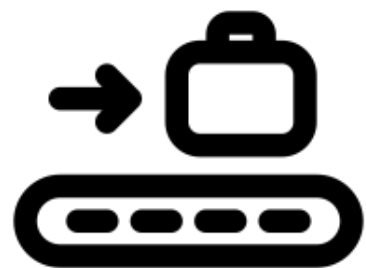

Employer Resources

In accordance with Education Code section 22325, CalSTRS shall, at least annually, identify and publish Resources that interpret and clarify the applicability of creditable compensation and creditable service laws.

Advisory letters

An advisory letter may be requested relating to compensation that is included, or is proposed to be included, in a publicly available written contractual agreement.

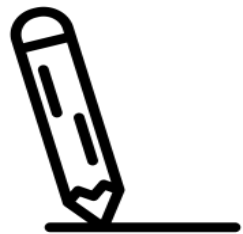
Employer Learning Center
