## BENEFITS AND SERVICES COMMITTEE CHARTER

# **INTRODUCTION**

The Benefits and Services Committee has been established to develop and oversee the execution of prudent policies relating to levels of benefits and the delivery of services to CalSTRS members, retirees and beneficiaries.

# **AUTHORITY**

- 1. To direct staff to undertake research on issues related to the benefits and services provided to CalSTRS members and beneficiaries and, if necessary, form task forces with representation from constituents and/or affected stakeholders.
- 2. To engage professional services consultants as necessary to assist the <u>c</u>Committee in fulfilling its responsibilities.

### **COMPOSITION**

The <u>c</u>Committee shall be composed of <u>all Board Members</u>. <u>a minimum of three (3) members</u> <u>appointed by the board chair</u>. The composition of the <u>c</u>Committee membership shall reflect the diversity of public, ex-officio and elected members on the <u>b</u>Board

Each <u>c</u>Committee member, within a year of appointment, will achieve reasonable proficiency in the <u>s</u>System's benefit structure and have an understanding of employee benefit structures in general.

## **MEETINGS**

The  $\underline{c}$ Committee will generally meet at each regularly scheduled  $\underline{b}$ Board meeting and otherwise onan as-needed basis as determined by the  $\underline{c}$ Committee  $\underline{c}$ Chair in consultation with the  $\underline{c}$ Chair of the  $\underline{b}$ Board.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

The Benefits and Services Committee shall have responsibility for the following:

- 1. To monitor and recommend to the bBoard all other actions with respect to benefits including levels of service and member communications
- 2. To review and recommend to the <u>b</u>Board all other actions with respect to the design, financing and administration of the <u>s</u>System's benefits structure.
- 3. To maintain and increase proficiency in the benefit structure, <u>c</u>Committee members are encouraged to make annual on-site visits to the Customer Contact Center and attend informational presentations to CalSTRS members.
- 4. To adhere to the Risk Management Policy established by the board.

- 5. To review emerging and significant risks specific to the area of responsibility of the Benefits and Services Committee and to report those risks to the board.
