PURPOSE

The purpose of this item is to review and receive input for the Appeals Committee work plan for the 2026-27 fiscal year.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the committee review its work plan for the 2026-27 fiscal year and identify training and educational opportunities.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with its committee charter and the Board Governance Manual, the Appeals Committee is required to meet as needed to timely hear, deliberate upon, and expeditiously decide appeals of CalSTRS determinations pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, the Teachers' Retirement Law, and the California Code of Regulations. The committee is also authorized to designate Precedential Decisions. Additionally, the committee is responsible for working with staff to identify training opportunities; adhere to the Risk Management Policy established by the board; review emerging and significant risks specific to the area of responsibility of the committee and to report those risks to the board; and to conduct the committee's work in a manner appropriately aligned with the CalSTRS strategic plan, including its mission and vision. The attached proposed work plan reflects the committee's responsibilities.
