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What is Subrogation?


- § 24500. Right of recovery from third person or entity on behalf of plan
- Subrogation is CalSTRS' right of recovery when a member's injury or death is caused by a third party.
- If a member is injured by a third party and those same impairment(s) entitle them to a CaISTRS disability benefit, CaISTRS may recover the actuarial value of the additional benefit payable.
- Survivor benefits/family allowances payable due to a member's death resulting from an act of a third party are also recoverable by CaISTRS.
- CalSTRS may file a legal action, intervene in the claim, or file a lien against any judgment that may be recovered by the member.

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
Subrogation process flow
