Item purpose

Executive summary

The Investment Committee's General Consultant, Meketa, will review the report of the Teachers' Retirement Fund's investment performance for the fiscal year and the ten, five, and three-year results ending June 30, 2026.

Staff has added a one-page, double-sided, investment performance “At-a-Glance” to provide the Committee and the public with a quick reference sheet (Attachment 1). This report can be customized to meet the Committee’s needs.

Meketa has developed a one-page abridged performance summary (Attachment 2) and will alert the Investment Committee of any issue or area that requires greater focus and attention.

Additionally, Meketa, along with State Street Bank Investment Analytics, provides the General Consultant Semi-Annual Performance Report (Attachment 3). This report can be customized to suit the needs of the Investment Committee. Underlying data within this report is provided by State Street Bank & Trust, the custodian, who maintains the investment performance book of record for the portfolio.

As requested by the Investment Committee, Meketa will provide detailed oversight of the RMS and SISS portfolios during the closed session.

Background

On a semi-annual basis, the General Consultant reviews the performance report for the CalSTRS Total Fund. The semi-annual reporting packet has been streamlined to align with the investment reporting guidelines approved in June 2016.
